

# NEW MEXICO BILINGUAL- BILITERACY SEAL



- The Seal of Bilingualism-Biliteracy is an award given by RRPS in recognition of students who have studied and, by high school graduation, attained proficiency in a language other than English.
- The Seal of Bilingualism-Biliteracy emblem appears on the diploma of the graduating senior (including a notation on the student's transcript) and encourages students to pursue biliteracy, honors the skills students attain, and can be evidence of skills that are attractive to future employers and college admissions offices.

**Option 2: Units of Credit and Assessment**

**Students must:**

- 1. Meet all NM PED and RRPS graduation requirements**
- 2. Earn 4 units of credit in the same language with a C or Better**
- 3. Earn a score of 3 or higher on one of the following AP exams: Chinese, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Latin, Spanish Language, Spanish Literature**  
consideration may be given to an intermediate score or higher on STAMP or AAPPL
